We also will sell fresh-cut leaves for propagation and hard-to-find supplies suitable for African violet growers.

PLACE: Blossom Garden Center, Main Street, Anywhere USA

FEATURES: Many unusual varieties of African violets on display and for sale: miniatures, semiminiatures, standards and trailers. Most of these plants are hybrids not available for sale locally. Pinks, whites and lavenders to darker violets and reds — plus the rarer greens. Solid blossoms, spotted, or "fantasy" blossoms, striped blossoms. Blossoms as small as a quarter-inch wide to ones over two inches wide! Quilted leaves, variegated leaves, ruffled leaves — a feast for the eyes!

Fresh-cut leaves for propagation will also be for sale.

Workshops for the public at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday and 2:00 p.m. Sunday focusing on growing violets, spotting problems, propagating leaves.
