Do you have toxic waste in your African violet pot?

Violets like small pots. They bloom better when potted in a pot that is smaller than the diameter of the leaves. But when the pot is very small, it is more likely that the pH will change quickly causing problems with the chemistry in the soil. To avoid problems, repot miniature and semi-miniature African violets 3-4 times a year. Standard violets in slightly larger pots should be repotted once or twice a year.
